## Parenting with Love and Logic

April 22nd & 29th, and May 6th, 13th, & 20th.**

*(This class will be running for 5 consecutive weeks)*

Helping children learn to make good choices is a parenting skill that doesn't come natural to all parents. Although your child is still very young it is not too early to begin to help your child. In fact the earlier you learn to think about how love and logic works the better you will be at it. We would encourage **all** parents to take this parenting class---yes, even if your child is perfect.

## Pre-Toddler Pointers

This month in PreToddler Parent Training Group we will be learning through playing with farm animals. We will be emphasizing expressive language development by making sounds such as "moo" and "baa". We will be developing cognitive skills by matching sounds to animals, practicing object permanence by hiding eggs, as well as pointing and gesturing to identify animals. We will also work on tolerating sticky textures by doing a glue, feathers, and cotton ball activity.
